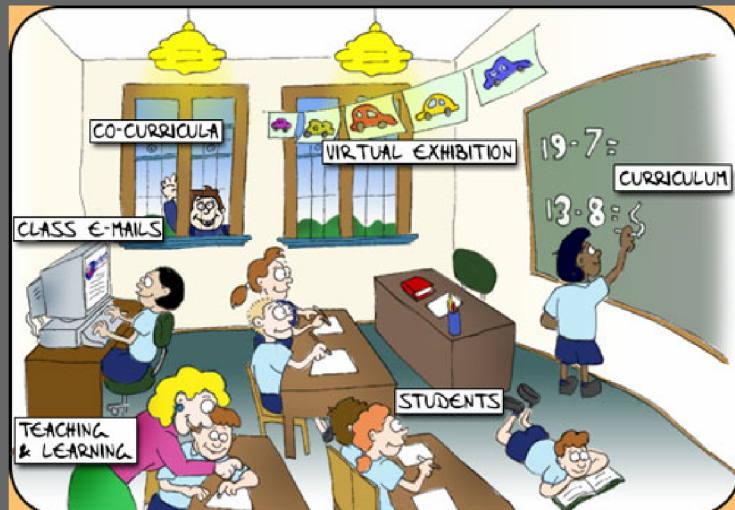
The Three P's:
